## FPC Post-Secondary Scholarships Guidelines

- A. Candidates for FPC Post-Secondary Scholarships include:
- 1. Member or friend (non-member) of FPC who is currently active in the church.
- 2. Child of member or friend (non-member) of FPC currently active in the church.
  - 3. Current FPC staff member.
  - 4. Child of current FPC staff member.
- 5. Applicant who has been active in FPC within the past 3 years, regardless of their parents' church affiliation.
- 6. Applicant who meets these guidelines, regardless of age, may request scholarship funds for post-secondary study, including undergraduate, graduate, or vocational schooling.
- B. In addition to completing the application form, the applicant will submit a resume which describes:
  - I. Their educational objectives
  - 2. Their scholastic achievement
- 3. Their statement of faith/description of faith journey, as well as their faith application (including church involvement, outreach and mission experiences and future desires.)
  - 4. Community involvement.
- C. A recipient is requested to make an effort to be present for recognition of scholarship recipients in worship on the designated Sunday. If unable, family member(s) or friends are encouraged to still attend.
- D. A student may receive four (4) total post-secondary scholarships over their educational experience.
